Garage Transition to City of Rutland & LAZ Partnership: Updates

BGS & the City of Rutland have signed an agreement to transfer management of the Rutland Multimodal Transit Center Parking Garage to the City of Rutland & their partners, LAZ Parking. Changes in management and operation of the facility go into full effect on: **July 1, 2014***.

The outcome of this transition is resulting in changes to existing parking agreements and permits for new users.

Procedure Change for Long Term Parking Permit Requests:

Forms should be completed for each permit requested and submitted to the point of contact for to the garage operator LAZ Parking.
