• Item #1 – Jireh Billings made a motion to accept the November 8, 2017 meeting minutes and Susan Hayward seconded the motion. The minutes were approved by all.

#### MOTION:

- Item #2 Ice Rink at the State House Pilot Project Susan Allen and Nate Hausman Jireh Billings made a motion to approve a second pilot year with the following conditions:
  - The rink will be the same size and located in the same location as last year.
  - The fence and signage will be the same as last year.
  - The lighting will be as presented in the new proposal.
  - Garland and wreaths will be hung on the street side of the fence.
  - At the June Capitol Complex Commission meeting in June 2018, a plan will be submitted to the Commission which will include design, engineering and funding for a more permanent ice rink. The plan will resolve the challenges of the ice rink on a sloped lawn and be in keeping with the historic nature of the Capital Complex District.
