BLUE MAIL BINS

Blue bins are the designated location for mail pickup and delivery for all locations except the WSOC. All blue bins will be labeled with your assigned zip+4.

In FY2019 we hope to implement an automated accountable mail system that will require adding a barcode to your blue bin for scanning upon delivery.



You can use separate bins (space permitting) or rubber-band groups together to separate the following outgoing pieces within a single bin:

- Outgoing Federal USPS
- Pre-Stamped Mail
- Pink Mail


ZIP+4 IS CRITICAL TO TIMELY DELIVERY

Your zip+4 is assigned by the BGS Postal Center and allows us to speed up the mail sorting and delivery process. We guarantee *same day delivery* of incoming USPS mail that includes a valid zip+4. The zip+4 list can be found under the Forms and Publications section of our website.

OUTGOING MAIL - TIPS & TRICKS

- Envelope ordering or label generation reminders:
 - Include your VISION billing number above your return address
 - Include your valid unique zip+4 in your return address

EXAMPLE:



- Include your zip+4 in your email signature
- Seal everything larger than 6"x9" and all pre-stamped envelopes
- International mail piece reminder:
 - Rubber-band all international pieces separately
 - Write out full country name on international pieces
 Canada (Correct) CA (Incorrect)
- Outgoing mail can be dropped at our Middlesex location until 4:15 pm for same day mailing (please allow more time for larger volumes of mail).
